You are hereby notified that the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee of the Los Angeles City Council will hold a public hearing on <u>Tuesday, August 14, 2012</u>, at approximately <u>2:30 p.m.</u>, or soon thereafter, in the Board of Public Works Edward R.
