An ordinance amending Section 42.00, Subsection (c), of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to remove the exception for sight-seeing tour operations from the prohibition of soliciting employment of services on the street.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (1) of Subsection (c) of Section 42.00 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) No person shall on any street offer for sale, solicit the employment of, or announce by any means the availability of, any goods, wares, merchandise, services or facilities, or solicit patrons for or advertise any show, exhibition, entertainment, tour, excursion, sight-seeing trip, or real estate viewing or inspection trip.

Sec. 2. Paragraph (3) of Subsection (c) of Section 42.00 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is repealed.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
