

The Boyle Heights Neighborhood Council seeks City Council approval to reappropriate \$6,994.08 from the Uncommitted Balance of FY 2011-12 Neighborhood Council Funds to pay an outstanding demand warrant to Boyle Heights Youth Football and to conduct outreach for the upcoming Neighborhood Council elections.

On February 18, 2010, the City Council voted to eliminate the rollover policy for the Neighborhood Council Funding Program. Consequently, the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment encumbered FY 2011-2012 funds to pay Neighborhood Council obligations that were not processed prior to the City Controller's deadline. This process resulted in the submission of over 400 requests for demand warrants, and unfortunately, the misplacement of this particular demand warrant.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council APPROVE the Controller to reappropriate \$6,994.08 from the Uncommitted Balance of FY 2011-12, Department of Neighborhood Empowerment Fund No. 44B/47, Account No. 471038 Boyle Heights NC to FY 2012-13, Department of Neighborhood Empowerment Fund 44B/47, Account No. 471038 Boyle Heights NC to pay the outstanding demand warrant and election outreach.
