

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the status of the Vandalism and Graffiti Trust Fund No. 870 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2012-13.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Mayor and Council dated October 17, 2013, the City Clerk states that the fund balance for the Vandalism and Graffiti Trust Fund No. 870 was \$52,469.02 as of June 30, 2012. The Fund realized net revenue in the amount of \$0.00, and total expenditures for claims in the amount of \$9,000.00, leaving a balance of \$43,469.02 as of June 30, 2013. According to the City Clerk, the Fund was established in 1989 for the receipt of fines and disbursement of rewards related to vandalism and graffiti.

At its meeting held November 8, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council note and file the City Clerk's report.
