SUMMARY

In a report to the Mayor and Council dated October 17, 2013, the City Clerk states that the fund balance for the Council District 8 Public Benefits Trust Fund No. 49F was \$35,122.33 as of June 30, 2012. The Fund realized net revenue in the amount of \$530,545.44, and total expenditures and encumbrances in the amount of \$50,285.84, leaving a balance of \$515,381.93 as of June 30, 2013. According to the City Clerk, the Fund was established in 2006 for the receipt, retention, and disbursements of gifts, contributions, bequests, and City fund appropriations for the support of police and community activities within Council District 8.

At its meeting held November 8, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council note and file the City Clerk's report.
