REV. DR. CLYDE W. ODEN, JR.

Rev. Dr. Clyde W. Oden, Jr., is Senior Pastor of Bryant Temple African Methodist Episcopal Church (A.M.E. Church). THE TEMPLE is a politically conscious Church, which engages the spiritual, social, and health concerns of the Leimert Park District and the greater South Los Angeles community. The Church has an active congregation of 650 persons.

THE TEMPLE has a number of ministries under the leadership of Rev. Oden. They have a Health Ministry with a focus on obesity, diabetes, prostate cancer and HIV/AIDS. The Church has sponsored several community health fairs with a particular focus on men and women's health issues. THE TEMPLE also supports Chosen Gospel Recovery Ministries which serves women who have been released from prison, and/or homeless and/or substance abusers; a Women's Ministry, a Men's Ministry, a Couple's Ministry, and a substance abuse ministry known as Free N One which provides a safe place for men and women struggling with the issues of addiction. THE TEMPLE is also the home of Selah Ministries, which promotes meditation and contemplation practices through its INNER SELF ACTUALIZATION PROGRAM (I.S.A.P), a project supported by the Angell Foundation. THE TEMPLE has a Veteran's Ministry and is the home base for Bryant Temple American Legion Post #109.

Beyond its local community, THE TEMPLE has been very active in reaching out to other communities of Faith. Dr. Oden has led his church to be an active member of L.A. Metropolitan Churches, where he serves on its Board of Directors. He also serves on the Board of Directors of Community Build, Inc.

Dr. Oden serves as co-chair to an Advisory Committee at the RAND Corporation examining the issues of HIV/AIDS in the faith community. He is a prostate cancer survivor and vigorously advocates for prostate cancer screening and cancer prevention, treatment and community health education.

Prior to Bryant Temple AME Church, Rev. Oden was Senior Pastor at Holy Trinity A.M.E. Church in North Long Beach, where he served for seven (7) years. During his tenure at Holy Trinity, Dr. Oden was bi-vocational, having served as Chairman of the Board of Directors of Family Savings Bank, and President and Chief Executive Officer of Watts Health Systems, Inc. He served at the Watts Health System's CEO from 1979 to 2002.

The Reverend Dr. Oden has four earned degrees from the University of California, at Berkeley including a Doctor of Optometry (O.D.) and a Masters in Public Health (M.P.H.). He also has earned Masters in Business Administration (M.B.A.) from Pepperdine University and a Masters in Divinity (M. Div.), from Claremont School of Theology.

He is married to Velma, a retired R.N., and they have three adult children, four grandchildren, and two great grandchildren.

Dear Dr. Oden:

I am pleased to inform you that I hereby appoint you to the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority for the term ending June 30, 2017. In order to complete the process as quickly as possible, there are several steps that must be taken, many of which require a trip downtown. If you require parking during these procedures, please call Sui Duong in my Office at (213) 978-0724 and he will arrange it for you.

To begin the appointment process, please review, sign and return the enclosed City Commissioner Ethics Pledge, Commission Remuneration Form, Undated Separation Form and Background Release within one week of receiving this letter. These documents are necessary to help us ensure the most efficient, open and accountable City government possible. Further, Mayor's Office policy requires you to be fingerprinted as part of the background check that is done on all potential Commissioners. To do so, please bring this letter to the Background Unit of Employment Services Division, Personnel Department Building, 700 East Temple Street, Room 235, Los Angeles, (213) 473-9343. Fingerprints must be taken within three working days from the receipt of this letter.

Under separate cover you will be receiving a packet from the City Ethics Commission containing information about the City's conflict of interest laws and a copy of the State Form 700/Statement of Economic Interests. City law requires that you complete and return this form **within 21 days** of your nomination to the City Ethics Commission, 200 North Spring Street, City Hall, 24th Floor, Los Angeles, California 90012. Any inquiries regarding this form should be directed to Shannon Prior at the Ethics Commission at (213) 978-1960.

As part of City Council confirmation process, you will need to arrange a meeting with Joe Buscaino, your Councilmember, and Councilmember Tony Cardenas, the Chair of the Housing, Community, and Economic Development Committee, to answer any questions they may have. You will be hearing from a City Council committee clerk who will let you know when your appointment will be considered by the Housing, Community, and Economic Development Committee. Some time thereafter, you will also be notified by the committee clerk when your appointment will be presented to the full City Council for confirmation. Once you are confirmed, you will be required to take the oath of office in the City Clerk's Office, Room 395, City Hall. Deputy Mayor Mercedes Marquez's staff will be responsible to assist you during the confirmation process if you have questions.

Commissioners must be residents of the City of Los Angeles. If you move at any point during your term, have any changes in your telephone numbers, or in the future plan to resign (resignation must be put in writing), please contact my office immediately.

Warmest congratulations and thank you for agreeing to continue helping in my efforts to serve the people of the City of Los Angeles.
