HOMELESSNESS AND POVERT

MOTION

The City's Asset Evaluation Framework (C.F. 12-1549-S3) is intended to help advance the City's economic development and housing efforts by establishing a uniform procedure to evaluate and designate City-owned properties for economic development, housing opportunities and/or other City purposes, as well as to identify higher and better uses for such properties in order to maximize the value of City assets and to address priority concerns such as housing affordability and homelessness.

In furthering the above efforts, there are two City-owned properties located at 928 Marine Avenue and 529 W. 11th Street in Council District 15 which may be suitable for development as permanent supportive housing to help address the City's homelessness and housing crisis.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Administrative Officer, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst, and any other affected stakeholders, be directed to initiate reviews of City-owned properties located at 928 Marine Avenue and 529 W. 11th Street in Council District 15, to determine the suitability for development as permanent supportive housing in conformance with the procedure set forth for the City's Asset Evaluation Framework.
