COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR and VICE CHAIR, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE relative to the Eight Amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement with the Southern California Coastal Water Research Project (SCCWRP) to support water quality research.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. APPROVE the intent and objectives of the proposed Eight Amended Joint Powers Agreement for the SCCWRP. The City's share of funding will be:

2. AUTHORIZE the Mayor or the President of the Board of Public Works to execute the Amendment and return the executed documents to the Bureau of Sanitation for further processing.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Administrative Officer reports that a total of \$1.6 million over four years (\$400,000 per year) will be provided from the Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund. The City's liability is limited to the total appropriations approved by the Mayor and Council. This complies with the City Financial Policies.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On November 7, 2012, the Energy and Environment Committee Chair and Vice Chair considered a Board of Public Works report dated June 20, 2012, relative to the Eight Amendment to the Joint Powers Agreement with the SCCWRP to support water quality research.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee Chair and Vice Chair recommended approval of the Board of Public Works report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
