

INNOVATION, TECHNOLOGY AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to authorization to destroy certain obsolete records from the Los Angeles World Airports, Accounting - Main Office (DOA/40 - 365 Boxes) for the period of January 1, 1948 through December 31, 1999.

Recommendation for Council action:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to authorize the destruction of certain obsolete records from the Los Angeles World Airports, Accounting - Main Office (DOA/40 - 365 Boxes) for the period of January 1, 1948 through December 31, 1999.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Clerk reports that the retention of 365 records boxes beyond the required retention time period, based on industry commercial standard rates, will continue to cost the City the equivalent of a minimum of \$56.94 per month, or \$683.28 per year.
