

INNOVATION, TECHNOLOGY AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a contract amendment between the City and Time Warner Cable and Quest Communications for the City's internet connectivity services.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Interim General Manager of the Information Technology Agency (ITA), or designee, to execute Amendment No. 2 to Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to City Contract C-116087 with Time Warner Pacific Cable West LLC, doing business as Time Warner Cable, for Citywide internet connectivity services, in order to increase maximum compensation by \$3 million for a new total contract compensation not to exceed \$6 million, and extend the term of the Contract by two years for a revised contract term effective eight years from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2017, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.
2. APPROVE and AUTHORIZE the Interim General Manager of the ITA, or designee, to execute Amendment No. 4 to City Contract C-117048 with Qwest Communications Company, LLC doing business as Centurylink QCC for Citywide internet connectivity services, in order to extend the term of the Contract by two years for a revised contract term effective seven years and six and a half months from March 15, 2010 through September 30, 2017, subject to the approval of the City Attorney.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer reports that there is no additional impact to the General Fund with the approval of the above recommendations. Funding for the proposed amendments is provided in the ITA's Communication Services account. Future funding for these agreements is contingent upon approval through the annual budget process. The recommendations in this report comply with the City's Financial Policies in that budgeted funds are available in the current fiscal year and future expenditures are limited to the appropriation of funds in the budget.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on June 9, 2015, the Innovation, Technology and General Services Committee considered a City Administrative Officer (CAO) report dated June 1, 2015 relative to a contract amendment between the City and Time Warner Cable and Quest Communications for the City's internet connectivity services. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee approved the recommendations in the June 1, 2015 CAO report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
