10. Grant Award Summary

The Office of the City Attorney requests authority to accept the supplemental grant to the Intellectual Property Enforcement Program from the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$200,000 for a two-year grant performance period from October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2015. The Council approved the acceptance of the original award on January 18, 2013 (C.F. 12-1936). The City Attorney's Office will utilize the supplemental grant to continue the Counterfeit Abatement Prosecution Program (CAPP), which addresses counterfeiting activities tied to organized crime by increasing filings of counterfeit nuisance abatement and unfair competition lawsuits.

The total cost of the program is \$237,908, of which \$200,000 will be reimbursed to the City as follows: \$148,368 in salaries, and \$51,632 in fringe benefits. Grant funding for salaries and fringe benefits will support the costs of one Deputy City Attorney IV assigned to this program. No additional position authority is needed as the authority for this position is provided through the 2013-14 Departmental Personnel Ordinance. There is no matching requirement for this grant, however, the City will have to bear overhead costs, which includes \$25,534 for central services costs and \$12,374 for department administration costs, totaling \$37,908, not reimbursed by the grant.

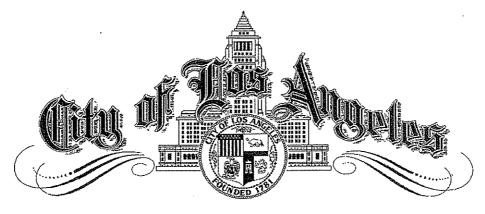
- 1. Approve the grant award between the City of Los Angeles and the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance and authorize the City Attorney, or his designee, to execute the grant award in the amount of \$200,000 for the Intellectual Property Enforcement Program, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality;
- 2. Authorize the City Attorney, or his designee, to accept the Intellectual Property Enforcement Program grant award in the amount of \$200,000 for funding the Counterfeit Abatement Prosecution Program for the period of October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2015;
- 3. Authorize the Controller to:
 - a. Establish a receivable within Fund 368, Department 12, in the amount of \$200,000
 - Increase appropriations within Fund 368 as follows:
 Account 12J261 FY 12-13 Intellectual Property Grant \$200,000
- 4. Upon receipt of grant funds, transfer up to \$200,000 from Fund 368, Department 12, Account 12J261 to Fund 100, Account 5301, Reimbursement from Other Funds/Dept; and.
- 5. Authorize the City Attorney to prepare Controller instructions for any necessary technical adjustments subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.

The total cost of the Counterfeit Abatement Prosecution Program is \$237,908, of which \$200,000 will be reimbursed by the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance. The General Fund impact will be \$37,908 for central services and department administration costs not reimbursed the grant. No additional appropriation is needed. The recommendations in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that budgeted appropriations will be balanced against receipts expected from this grant.

Dear Mayor Garcetti and Members of City Council:

The City Attorney's Office is transmitting for your review and approval acceptance of a supplemental grant award in the amount of \$200,000 from the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, under the Intellectual Property Enforcement Program. This award will support counterfeit abatement enforcement actions in the City of Los Angeles from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2015.

With federal funding, the Los Angeles City Attorney's Office ("LACA") will maintain the Counterfeit Abatement Prosecution Program (CAPP) to address physical locations where chronic counterfeiting activities occur. Increased filing of counterfeit nuisance abatement and unfair competition lawsuits will take place as part of a broader local, state, and federal strategy that includes the Los Angeles Police Department, Los Angeles County Sheriff, and Federal Bureau of Investigation. CAPP will also strengthen existing local intellectual property task force efforts through heightened coordination and collaboration related to abatements.

Los Angeles is the epicenter of intellectual property theft and home to sophisticated entities that sell counterfeit goods to further advance their criminal operations. Counterfeiting activities frequently cross pollinate with violence, weapons, and narcotics - posing grave public safety risks. During FY 2012-13, CAPP effectively addressed

chronic counterfeit locations through property owner notification letters, hearings with property owners, and the filing of counterfeit abatement legal actions.

Acceptance of the FY 2013-2015 Intellectual Property Enforcement Program supplemental funding will continue to improve the performance and efficiency of intellectual property enforcement efforts and increase public safety.

IT IS THEREFORE REQUESTED that the City Council and the Mayor:

- 1. Authorize the City Attorney or his designee to **APPROVE** the accompanying grant award between the City and the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, and authorize the City Attorney or his designee to **EXECUTE** said grant award on behalf of the City, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality.
- 2. Authorize the City Attorney or his designee to **ACCEPT** the grant award in the amount of \$200,000 for funding the Counterfeit Abatement Prosecution Program for the period of October 1, 2013 September 30, 2015.
- 3. **AUTHORIZE** the Controller to:
 - a. **ESTABLISH** a receivable in the amount of \$200,000 within Fund 368, Department 12.
 - b. **ESTABLISH** Appropriation Account 12K261 FY 13-14 Intellectual Property Grant within Fund 368, Department 12 in the amount of \$200,000.
 - c. **TRANSFER** \$54,387 from Fund 368, Department 12, Account 12K261 FY 13-14 Intellectual Property Grant to Fund 100, Department 12, Account 1020 Salaries Grant Reimbursed.
- 5. **AUTHORIZE** the City Council to Instruct the City Clerk to place on Council Calendar for July 1, 2014, the following action relative to the Counterfeit Abatement and Prosecution Program:

"That the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, **AUTHORIZE** the Controller to transfer \$72,516 from Fund 368, Department 12, Account 12K261 FY 13-14 Intellectual Property Grant to Fund 100, Department 12, Account 1020 Salaries Grant Reimbursed."
