TRANSMITTAL OF THE GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE 2012-2013 SUBJECT: BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM GRANT

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

- 1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE this report.
- 2. That the Board TRANSMIT the attached grant application, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 14.6(a), to the Mayor, Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Office of the Chief Legislative Analyst and to the City Clerk for committee and City Council consideration.
- 3. That the Board REQUEST the Mayor and City Council, should the grant be awarded, to:
  - A. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police to ACCEPT the grant award for the 2012-2013 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program (BVP) in the amount of \$65,905.53 from the Bureau of Justice Administration, United States Department of Justice, for the period of April 1, 2013 through August 31, 2015;
  - B. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to spend up to the grant amount in accordance with the grant award agreement;
  - C. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in Fund 339, Department 70;
  - D. AUTHORIZE the Controller to set up a grant receivable and establish an appropriations account, account number to be determined within Fund 339, Department 70, for disbursement of the 2012-2013 BVPProgram Grant in accordance with the grant award agreement;
  - E. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller Instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the CAO, and AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the Controller to implement the instructions.

#### DISCUSSION

The LAPD has been arecipient of the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program Grant for the past 12 years. As a result of grant funding, LAPD has been able to purchase National Institute of Justice (NIJ) compliant armored vests for police officers.

The \$65,905.53 grant will provide funding for approximately 1,000 replacement vests, recruit vests, and tactical concealable body armor. The Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance will reimburse the Department 50 percent of the cost of each vest purchased. The Department has participated in the BVP Program for twelve years with total funding awarded in the amount of \$3,050,235.63.
