RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing a position in the City's 2013-14 Federal Legislative Program on AB 703 (Hall).

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Resolution (Englander - Buscaino):

INSTRUCT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to prepare a Resolution substantially similar to Resolution (Englander - Buscaino), to establish a position of support in the City's 2013-14 Federal Legislative Program for AB 703 (Hall) which would entitle retired level I peace officers to an endorsement for a Concealed Carry Weapon permit, if the retiree carried a firearm in the course of their duties and served the minimum amount of time to retire as specified by the agency, and seek amendment to extend this entitlement to retired level II peace officer reserves.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## Summary:

At its regular meeting held August 16, 2013, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered this matter. At that time, Councilmember Englander addressed the Committee and asked that the CLA be instructed to prepare an amended Resolution to establish a position of support in the City's 2013-14 Federal Legislative Program for AB 703 (Hall), which would entitle retired levell peace officers to an endorsement for a Concealed Carry Weapon permit, if the retiree carried a firearm in the course of their duties and served the minimum amount of time to retire as specified by the agency, and seek amendment to extend this entitlement to retired level II peace officer reserves.

The Committee concluded its consideration of this matter and recommended that Council approve the recommendation of Councilmember Englander. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
