reports as follows:

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the City's position to support Assembly Bill (AB) 48 (Skinner) which would initiate controls on ammunition sales.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Parks – Perry), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2013-14 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 48 (Skinner) which would require vendors of ammunition for firearms to be licensed, and would require purchasers to show identification when purchasing ammunition, and subject buyers to background check and possible enforcement if they are not allowed to own a gun.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


Summary:

At its regular meeting of May 17, 2013, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report dated May 7, 2013 and Resolution (Parks – Perry) relative to the City's position to support AB 48 (Skinner) which would require vendors of ammunition for firearms to be licensed, and would require purchasers to show identification when purchasing ammunition, and subject buyers to background check and possible enforcement if they are not allowed to own a gun. The CLA report, attached to Council File No. 13-0002-S49, provides a summary of the Resolution and additional background information.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.

RESOLUTION

RULES, ELECTIONS & INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS

WHEREAS, any official position of the City of Los Angeles with respect to legislation, rules, regulations or policies proposed to or pending before a local, state or federal governmental body or agency must have first been adopted in the form of a Resolution by the City Council with the concurrence of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, one of the most far-reaching gun-control measures proposed this year in California was passed in the Assembly Public Safety Committee by a vote of 5-2 yesterday after its author said it is needed to address an "epidemic of gun violence" in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the bill, AB 48 by Assemblywoman Nancy Skinner (D-Berkeley) would require ammunition to be sold by licensed dealers, would require buyers to provide identification and subject them to background checks and possible enforcement if they are not eligible to carry guns; and

WHEREAS, the bill would also outlaw kits for magazines capable of holding more than 10 rounds and require the state to notify local law enforcement agencies when someone buys more than 3,000 rounds of ammunition in a five-day period; and

WHEREAS, the bill addresses issues raised in recent mass shootings in Connecticut and Colorado; and

WHEREAS, although the State already requires people to show ID when buying cigarettes, alcohol and some cough medicines, it is easier now to buy bullets than to buy alcohol, cigarettes or Sudafed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, with the concurrence of the Mayor, that by the adoption of this Resolution, the City of Los Angeles hereby includes in its 2013-2014 State Legislative Program support for AB 48 (Skinner) which would require ammunition to be sold by licensed dealers, would require buyers to provide identification and subject them to background checks and possible enforcement if they are not eligible to carry guns.
