Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Garcetti – Alarcón – Reyes),

Program SUPPORT for H.R. 1217 (Becerra – Rose-Lehtinen), the Smithsonian American Latino
Museum Act, which would authorize a plan to create a Smithsonian American Latino Museum.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City
Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting of April 19, 2013, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations
Committee considered a CLA report dated April 15, 2013 and Resolution (Garcetti – Alarcón –
Reyes) relative to the City's position to support the Smithsonian American Latino Museum Act,
H.R. 1217 (Garcetti – Alarcón – Reyes), which would which would authorize a plan to create a
Smithsonian American Latino Museum. The CLA report, attached to Council File No. 13-0002-
S52, provides a summary of the Resolution and additional background information.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council
adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its
consideration.

RESOLUTION

APR 3 2013

WHEREAS, any official position of the City of Los Angeles with respect to legislation, rules, regulations or policies proposed to or pending before a local, state, or federal governmental body or agency must have been adopted in form of a Resolution by the City Council with the concurrence of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, according to the Census, in 2011 Los Angeles County was comprised of 48.1% of persons of Latino origin; and

WHEREAS, the history of Los Angeles is significantly tied to the history of Latinos; and

WHEREAS, On March 15, 2013, Congressman Xavier Becerra of California and Congresswoman Ileana Ros-Lehtinen of Florida introduced H.R. 1217, in the 1st session of the 113th Congress, to establish within the Smithsonian Institution the Smithsonian American Latino Museum; and

WHEREAS, H.R. 1217, also known as The 'Smithsonian American Latino Museum' Act will authorize a plan of action for the creation of a Smithsonian American Latino Museum; and

WHEREAS, such a museum will honor the contributions and history of Latinos in Los Angeles and the United States of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, with the concurrence of the Mayor, that by the adoption of this Resolution, the City of Los Angeles hereby includes in its 2013-2014 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for H.R. 1217 which would establish within the Smithsonian Institution the Smithsonian American Latino Museum.
