

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance amending Section 19.129.15 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to extend the deadline for submitting an application for a reward under the Hit-and-Run Reward Program and to provide a mechanism for the City Council to reauthorize expired reward offers.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Subsection 3 of Section 19.129.15 of Article 2.3 of Chapter 12 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

3. Any person interested in seeking a reward under this article shall complete an "Information and Application for Reward" form prepared by and available from the Office of the City Clerk. In the event the applicant is under 18 years of age, the applicant's parent or legal guardian must also sign the form indicating his or her consent to the submission of the application. The applicant shall mail the completed form to the Los Angeles Police Department (Department) at the address indicated on the form. All applications must be submitted within six months of the date of the act referred to in the application.


Sec. 2. A new Subsection 6 is added to Section 19.129.15 of Article 2.3 of Chapter 12 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to read as follows:

6. If the Department determines that the circumstances of a particular hit-and-run warrant the reauthorization of an expired reward offer, it may transmit a report to the City Council recommending such action. Upon receipt of such a report, the City Council may approve the reauthorization of a reward offer. If the City Council approves the reauthorization of a reward offer, it shall direct the City Clerk or the Department, as appropriate, to advertise the reauthorization.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
