Honorable Members:

As requested by the City Council, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance would amend Section 19.129.15 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to extend the deadline for submitting an application for a reward under the Hit-and-Run Reward Program to six months after a hit-and-run incident. The law currently limits it to 60 days. It would also provide a mechanism for the City Council to reauthorize expired reward offers.
