For your consideration I would like to offer the following bullet points of my thoughts.

Again, I thank you for your time and appreciate the feeling that you welcomed the public comments and input, I felt that you all were open minded, and that my thoughts were important to you.

Additional Talking Points:

- Change cost money, Matrix needs to let council know what is "the full cost of combining the departments", Even thought I believe the lead agency should be Building and SAFTEY (should this consolidation effort go through), either way everyone needs to know the true cost. From Personnel, Real Estate, Printing, Move Cost, Real Estate etc.
- "Bigger is not always better" Transparency is blurred, when something gets too large.
- I am concerned that Matrix is tasked with "how to implement the consolidation of the departments" I think that
 is a error, they should also be tasked to advise if the consolidation makes sense ? I would think that they should
 look at surrounding cities, and see how their permit processes and their Building and Safety Items are handled, If
 they do a good job the report back to you in the surprising efficiencies of LADB&S
- I am aware that this consolidation idea was a part Mayor Villaraigosa's Budget, but I truly believe that this
 undertaking should be re-visited by the current City Council, Including the new Mayor, and New Council
 Members, as well as the existing Council Members.
- LADB&S is accessible, their efficiencies allow us to obtain permits in a timely fashion, and receive timely Building and Safety Inspections, this allows us to build on schedule, and stay on schedule, which is great for our business, and good for our clients in Los Angeles
- LADB&S treats the contractors like customers, and they are respectful of timelines, the need for fast permits and inspections. They are courteous, and helpful. I am concerned that this will go away under the larger consolidated " Planning and Development" department.
- The Management of LADB&S promotes customer service, I have attached some old correspondence to show that this customer service is consistent, even going back over 13 years, the attitude of the department continues to get better, the management strives to be the best Building and Safety in the region. From the most upper management to the rank and file inspectors, to even the clerks.
- Implementing new Ideas is good, but trying to completely fix something that is not broken is not good. LADB&S continues to be innovative and provides better service year after year.
