

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a donation of military items, valued at \$454,986.83, for use by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE LAPD to accept a donation of military items, valued at \$454,986.83, from the Federal Excess Property 1033 Program, for use by LAPD's Military Property Acquisition Team, Incident Command Post Unit, and Emergency Operations Division, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated June 21, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of military items, valued at \$454,986.83. The donation consists of 294 cartridge magazines, 8 hot weather boots, 1 pair of elbow pads, 596 field packs, 8 space heaters, 75 sleeping bags, 2 tool boxes, 8 tool hand O/T power (folding hand shovels), and 30 night vision image intensifiers. The donation will be distributed to various LAPD entities to enhance operational capabilities. On June 25, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held August 23, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation and thank the donor for this generous gift.
