PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of registration fees for Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) employees to attend the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates 2013 Professional Training and Development Symposium.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE LAPD to accept the donation of registration fees valued at \$20,000, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, for LAPD employees to attend the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates 2013 Professional Training and Development Symposium, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated March 1, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of registration fees for LAPD employees to attend the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates 2013 Professional Training and Development Symposium. The Department reports that the symposium will explore and address issues of post traumatic syndrome, mental health, public safety employee suicides, internet predators, child pornography and exploitation, as well as aid in developing investigative skills in spotting deception. On March 5, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held April 12, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners.
