SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF MONETARY DONATION

RECOMMENDED ACTION

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) APPROVE the Department's Report and TRANSMIT to the Mayor and City Council for ACCEPTANCE the donation in the amount of \$35,000 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to support overtime for detectives assigned to Valley Crisis and Recovery Services (CARES) Family Justice Center (FJC).
2. That the Board AUTHORIZE the Controller to deposit the monetary donation of \$35,000.00 to the Police Department Trust Fund 885, Department 70, Revenue Source 4513 and TRANSFER the same amount to Fund 100, Department 70, Revenue Source 5301.
3. That the Board AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department to prepare Controller's instructions for any technical adjustments consistent with this action, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and, REQUEST that the Controller implement the instructions.

DISCUSSION

The donation will be used to pay overtime to detectives assigned to Valley CARES FJC's Lethality Risk Reduction Project in Van Nuys Area. The Los Angeles Police Department envisions that the Valley CARES FJC Lethality Risk Reduction Project will achieve key outcomes to improve victim safety and reduce the risk of lethality by enhancing the efficiency and strength of the service delivery system for victims of domestic violence. As the Valley CARES FJC sustains increases in successful prosecution for domestic violence cases involving

strangulation and/or sexual assault, it will work toward expanding the reach of training and community outreach and education to other parts of the City. The overtime rate was based on the average salary for the rank of Detectives I, II and III as provided by Fiscal Operations Division.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Los Angeles Police Department.
