COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to the donation of an emergency response trailer from AT&T for use by Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE LAPD to accept the donation of an emergency response trailer valued at \$50,136.61 from AT&T, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated May 31, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of an emergency response trailer from AT&T. According to LAPD, the trailer will be used by the Incident Command Post Unit, Emergency Operations Division, to enhance operational capabilities of hazardous devices and materials investigations in Emergency Services Division, officer-involved shooting investigations conducted by Force Investigation Division, high profile investigations conducted by Robbery-Homicide Division, Special Weapons and Tactics personnel in Metropolitan Division, and patrol personnel under Office of Operations. On June 4, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At the Public Safety Committee meeting held June 28, 2013, the Committee Chair and Member recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
