SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated July 26, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of military items, valued at \$250,507.59. The donation consists of 2 power generator systems, 121 field hospital beds, 1 battery charger, 50 large military-style backpacks, 60 sleeping bags, and 37 rifleman backpack sets. The donation will be distributed to various LAPD entities to enhance operational capabilities. On July 30, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held August 23, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation and thank the donor for this generous gift.
