PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of X-26 TASER Electronic Control Devices and X-26 Dataport Kits for use by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE LAPD to accept the donation of 30 X-26 TASER Electronic Control Devices and 48 X-26 Dataport Kits valued at \$33,452.76 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated January 4, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of X-26 TASER Electronic Control Devices and X-26 Dataport Kits. The X-26 TASER is one of many force options deployed by LAPD. The Department reports that the Chief of Police recently mandated that the data captured on electronic control devices be downloaded as a permanent record of the use of force. The 48 X-26 Dataport Download Kits will assist personnel perform this task. On January 8, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held February 8, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners.
