AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept a monetary donation in the amount of \$37,775 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for 1,200 cadets to attend the annual LAPD Cadet Recreation Day at Knotts Berry Farm, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

## SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated November 8, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a monetary donation for cadets to attend the annual LAPD Cadet Recreation Day at Knotts Berry Farm. The Department reports that the donations will cover recreational entrance fees, t-shirts, food and drinks, auxiliary transportation, and miscellaneous items for the cadets. On November 19, 2013, the Board approved the Department's request.

At its meeting held December 13, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize the LAPD to accept this donation, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners.
