




Training Division (TD) is requesting a grant for 50 Model X26P TASER Electronic Control Weapons (ECWs) with support equipment. The equipment is necessary and will be used to conduct field tests of the newest model TASER offered by TASER International Inc. The manufacturer recently introduced this model as the next generation ECW to eventually replace the older model X26 TASER.

The Department currently has over 1300 Model X26 TASERs in the field. The end of their serviceability remains undetermined. Therefore, it is incumbent upon the Department to obtain the 50 test units. It will be placed into field operations in order to conduct a product evaluation of their effectiveness, enhanced technology, and durability. TASER International Inc. has agreed to donate the test units and support equipment via the Los Angeles Police Foundation at the conclusion of the product evaluation. This one time unsolicited donation is valued at approximately \$48,362.10.
