DISCUSSION

The donation will benefit the Metropolitan Division SWAT Team. This is a fiber optic camera mounted on a pole and primarily used by SWAT personnel during crisis events to monitor the whereabouts or demeanor of an armed or violent individual from a safe distance or behind cover. Approval of this grant will allow the Department to replace a fiber optic camera that was significantly damaged by a violent robbery suspect during a barricaded incident in May 2012. The requested camera is a newer model that offers digital recording and has a wireless kit that allows the recording to be broadcasted on three different channels for better monitoring. The equipment comes with a one year limited warranty to repair or replace the product at the option of Instrument Technology Incorporated.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.


