#### **COMMENTS**

The Department of City Planning (Planning) requests \$16,820 in funding from the Construction Services Trust Fund (CSTF) to purchase new furniture for two conference rooms at the Figueroa Plaza Public Counter (C.F. 13-0076). Both Planning and Department of Building and Safety staff meet with applicants in the conference rooms for extensive plan reviews and condition clearances. The existing furniture came from the City's salvage warehouse and is both worn and in disrepair (see attached photographs). The Department received a bid from Unisource Solutions Haworth, a City approved vendor for furniture, and provided the bid with its November 1, 2012 transmittal. The furniture to be procured includes two 42" by 72" tables (\$959), 22 seminar chairs (\$8,770), and 20 stacking chairs (\$4145). Labor and taxes are quoted at \$2,946.

The CSTF receives revenue from a two percent surcharge on all transactions that occur at the City's constituent Construction Services Centers, also known as the One-Stop Centers (One-Stops). Expenditures from the CSTF must be made to support or enhance the quality of services at the One-Stops. While Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 5.321 stipulates that CSTF requests be submitted first to the Construction Services Committee (CSC) for review and approval, this report is being forwarded without CSC consideration as the CSC is in the process of restructuring and is not expected to meet in a timely manner for the review of this request. In the event the Council and Mayor choose to approve Planning's request, the remaining available balance of the CSTF will be approximately \$6.8 million.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, approve funding in the amount of \$16,820 from the Construction Services Trust Fund 438/50 for the Department of City Planning to purchase new furniture for conference rooms at the Figueroa Plaza Public Counter.
