GENERAL EXEMPTION, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed amendment to Contract No. 7042 with Griffith Company, for the construction of Van Norman Chloramination Stations Nos. 1 and 2.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. FIND that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to the General Exemption as described in Section No. 15061(b)(3) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
- CONCUR with the Board of Water and Power Commissioners' action of January 25, 2013, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, Resolution No. 013-163, authorizing the amendment to Contract No. 7042 extending the contract by 26 months to May 15, 2013, for the construction of the Van Norman Chloramination Station Nos. 1 and 2 with the Griffith Company.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The City Administrative Officer reports that approval of the proposed resolution will have no impact to the City's General Fund. Approval of this request extends the term of the Agreement by 26 months from March 21, 2011 to May 15, 2013. It does not increase the contract limit of \$37,766,023 from the Water Revenue Fund. This Agreement and the Amendment is consistent with the Department's Financial Policies which are not applicable.
