**DRAFT ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTIONS (d) AND (e) AND ADDING
SUBSECTION (h) TO SECTION 80.58.1 OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE

ADD PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR THE FREE-FLOATING PROGRAM**

Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. The draft ordinance amends Subsections (d) and (e) and adds Subsection (h) to Section 80.58.1 to the Los Angeles Municipal Code to establish a fee schedule for the Carshare Program and to add parking restrictions for the Free-Floating Program.

Fee Notice Requirement

This draft ordinance would impose a new fee and, therefore, notice of its proposed adoption should be given in accordance with the provisions of California Government Code sections 66018 and 6062a. Those sections of State law require that, prior to adoption of a new or increased fee, a public hearing be held and notice of that hearing be published in a newspaper with two publications at least five days apart over a ten-day period. The notice period begins the first day of publication, and there must

be at least five days intervening between the first and the second publications, not counting the dates of publication.

Rule 38 Referral


