## ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance repealing in their entirety Ordinance No. 168,871, which established the Warner Center Transportation Demand Management and Traffic Mitigation Restitution Trust Fund, and Ordinance No. 168,868, which established the Warner Center Intercept Parking Facility Trust Fund.
