GENERAL EXEMPTION, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed Amendment No. 2 to nine existing agreements to assist the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) with the implementation of its ongoing Renewable Portfolio Standard Programs.

Recommendations for Council action:
