GENERAL EXEMPTION, ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed Amendment No. 1 to Agreement No. 47721-8 between the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) and Intergraph Corporation for the Geospatial Electric System Maintenance Program.

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. FIND that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to the General Exemption as described in Section No. 15061(b)(3) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
- 2.
