The United Firefighters of Los Angeles City (UFLAC) announced on its website that it has signed off on a letter of agreement with the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) to staff all Dodger home games this season.

The agreement calls for the provision of two Advanced Life Support rescue ambulances, one Basic Life Support rescue ambulance, and one Emergency Medical Services Captain to be detailed to Dodger home games.

Both the LAFD and UFLAC should be applauded for their entrepreneurial thinking. It is important too, that the details of this plan be understood prior to entering any agreement with the Dodgers.

I THEREFORE MOVE, that prior to entering any agreement with the Dodgers, that the LAFD, CAO, and City Attorney review the proposed agreement and bring to the Public Safety Committee a detailed analysis of the operational, financial, and legal implications of said agreement.
