MOTION


Freehab is a residential, 12-step drug and alcohol rehabilitation center located in the Sun Valley area of Council District Seven. Freehab is unique in that clients are not charged for their treatment, and the facility can accommodate as many as 200 drug and alcohol addicts at one time. The Freehab facility is currently undergoing a construction remodel and is expected to reopen in October 2013.

Council District Seven has requested that Council allocate Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) savings in the amount of \$500,000 from the Pacoima Retail Space Project (CD 7) to assist Freehab with necessary capital improvements, subject to CDBG review and eligibility.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor:

1. Reprogram Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$500,000 from the Pacoima Retail Space Project to the Freehab Rehabilitation Project and other eligible expenses, subject to CDBG review and eligibility.
2. Authorize the Controller to:
  - a. Establish a new account for Freehab in the amount of \$500,000 within the Community Development Trust Fund No. 424; and
  - b. Decrease Account 22J242 – Pacoima Retail Space in the amount of \$500,000 within the Community Development Trust Fund No. 424.
3. Authorize the City Administrative Officer and Chief Legislative Analyst to make any technical adjustments that may be required and are consistent with this action, and instruct the Controller to implement these instructions.
