Background



- Previous Revocable Permit (1995) and Agreement 2069 (1998) issued to California Cartage Company to conduct transloading operations
- Entitlements were terminated by the Harbor Department August 2013
- Sublicense issued by BNSF to CalCartage to continue operations during the SCIG preconstruction development process

Background (Continued)



- In October 2017 CalCartage was purchased by NFI Industries, Inc., the parent company of California Transload Services, LLC
- The Court ordered the City to set aside the permit and decertify the Environmental Impact Report
- New lease document is required to impose effective terms and conditions on premises and occupancy
