

Pursuant to Los Angeles Administrative Code 2.7.5, transmitted herewith for your consideration is Resolution No. 18-8359 authorizing approval of Revocable Permit No. 18-08 with California Transload Services, LLC (CTS); which was approved at the September 20, 2018 Board of Harbor Commissioners meeting. California Transload Services is the successor in interest to California Cartage Company which was acquired by CTS' parent company, NFI Industries in October 2017. CTS uses an 85.51 acre site located at 2401 E. Pacific Coast Highway in Wilmington for a large transloading and truck staging operation. Revocable Permit 18-08 is for a term of 30 days. Annual revenue is expected to be \$5,363,725 with annual adjustments based on the Consumer Price Index, All Urban Areas, Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim. There is no impact to the General Fund.
