SUMMARY

The City of Los Angeles has received notice of a grant award under the 2017-2018 Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), California Department of Education (CDE). The Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) requests authority to accept this grant in the approximate amount of Eight Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$815,000).

Pursuant to the Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 14.6 et seq., RAP is transmitting copies of the grant application, grant award notification, and the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners' Board Report No. 18-058, which was approved on April 4, 2018, relative to CDE 2017-18 SFSP grant.

The SFSP is a federally funded program administered by CDE that reimburses agencies for providing free nutritious meals during the summer to children 18 years of age and younger. RAP historically submits an annual application to the CDE for its Summer Food Service Program that is administered at over 100 sites throughout the City of Los Angeles. RAP has participated in the SFSP since 1975.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The projected expenses for RAP's SFSP for 2018 will be approximately \$851,000.00, and the anticipated reimbursement is \$815,000.00. As a result, the difference of \$36,000.00 will create a fiscal impact to RAP's General Fund.
