MOTION

In September, 2011, the California Legislature passed AB 818 (Blumenfield) – the Renter’s Right to Recycle Act – which requires owners of multifamily apartment buildings of five or more units to ensure that recycling services are available to those renting those units. The Act also required local jurisdictions to adopt ordinances mandating adequate areas for collecting and loading recyclable materials in new development projects. As the City moves towards meeting its recycling and waste diversion goals, it is important to know the status of the City’s implementation of the Act’s requirements and goals.

I THEREFORE MOVE, that the Bureau of Sanitation be instructed to report on the status of recycling programs and requirements at multifamily apartment complexes in the City, and to include in that report the percentage of multifamily dwellings that are participating in recycling programs, both in the City as a whole and in each individual Council District.
