DCP and LADOT staff gave the Committee background information on the matter. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee recommended that Council receive and file the joint DCP and LADOT reports submitted in response to Motion (Price - Bonin). Transportation Committee waived consideration of this matter on May 14, 2014. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
