J-15496-175
(Quitclaim of Water and Power Distribution Easements)

BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. Those permanent easements across certain real property herein described, owned by the City of Los Angeles and under the control of its Department of Water and Power, are no longer required for the use of the City and the Department, and should be abandoned and quitclaimed as herein authorized.

Section 2. The abandonment and quitclaiming of said easements is authorized and directed. The President or the Vice President of the Board, or the General Manager of the Department, (or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing), and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary or the Acting Secretary of the Board, be and they are hereby authorized and directed, after due authorization from the City Council, to execute, acknowledge and deliver an instrument in writing, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, quitclaiming unto the owner of record said easements, hereinafter described, and all rights, title, and interest therein.

Section 3. The Council of the City of Los Angeles is requested to authorize execution, acknowledgment, and delivery of said instrument in writing, quitclaiming said easements, as aforesaid.

Section 4. Said easements herein authorized to be quitclaimed and abandoned are upon and across real property described in Items 1 to 12, inclusive, as:

(P-78330, Map 166-165)

The southerly 14 feet of the northerly 20 feet of Lots 53 and 54 of Tract No. 11525, in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as per map recorded in Book 250, Pages 18 and 19 of Map Records, in the office of the County Recorder of said County.

<u>ITEM 2</u> (P-78576, Map 158-189)

That portion of Lot 6 of Tract No. 25663, in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as per map recorded in Book 700, Pages 22 through 24 of Map Records, in the office of the County Recorder of said County, lying within a strip of land, 5 feet in width, the sidelines of said strip of land being 2.5 feet on each side of the following described centerline:





PURPOSE

Transmitted for approval by your Honorable Board is a Resolution, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, recommending to the Los Angeles City Council approval of the execution of a Quitclaim Deed consisting of twelve (12) LADWP distribution easements.

COST AND DURATION

There is no cost to LADWP.

BACKGROUND

The easements proposed to be quitclaimed were voluntarily granted to LADWP and were reviewed by both Water and Power systems and deemed no longer needed by LADWP; therefore, it is recommended that they be quitclaimed at the established rate of \$4,250 for each item to be paid, in advance, to LADWP by the requestor as follows:

PROPOSED RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF 12 QUITCLAIM

DEEDS FOR 12 WATER AND POWER DISTRIBUTION EASEMENTS

SUMMARY

The Department of Water and Power (DWP; Department) requests approval of a proposed resolution which authorizes the DWP to quitclaim (to release or relinquish a legal claim) 12 water and power distribution easements. The DWP has determined that these easements are no longer required for use by the Department. Charter Section 675(d)(2) requires Council approval to dispose of real property. The City Attorney has approved the proposed resolution as to form and legality.

DWP periodically reviews applications requesting that the Department abandon DWP owned easements. The requests are from property owners who often are seeking to remove easement restrictions that were required for earlier building permits or tract maps. If the Department determines that an easement is no longer necessary for current or future DWP operations, a quitclaim deed is processed to transfer the rights of the easement to the existing property owner, thereby, effectively terminating the easement. DWP states that each of the 12 applicants is to pay the Department a processing fee of \$4,250. The amount of the processing fee was established in August 2008 by the DWP Board of Commissioners. There is no other cost from the Department to a property owner who requests a quitclaim.

Upon review of the attached DWP request, it is the opinion of this Office that it can be approved, as the requested action appears to be reasonable and in accordance with City policies and procedures.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Mayor:

- 1. Approve the proposed resolution which authorizes the Department of Water and Power to execute 12 quitclaim deeds for 12 water and power distribution easements; and
- 2. Return the proposed resolution to the Department for further processing, including Council consideration.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Approval of the proposed resolution will result in revenue to the Water Revenue Fund and Power Revenue Fund of \$4,250 for each quitclaim resulting in a total of \$51,000. The proposed action complies with the Department's adopted Financial Policies. Approval of the proposed resolution will have no impact on the City's General Fund.

TIME LIMIT FOR COUNCIL ACTION

Pursuant to Charter Section 675(d)(2), "Powers and Duties of the Board – Real Estate Interests," subject to the water rights of the City, there is no time limit for Council action on agreements for real property or any rights in real property held by DWP that will be sold, leased or withdrawn from the Department's control.
