That if it does "Re-Construction", it would have to be combined with other streets that have just Re-Surfacing" because of the expense. <u>We have asked the City since the January 17, 1994, EARTHQUAKE</u> about the more than <u>2" bulking of our street.</u>

### <u>CONDITION OF STREET</u>

### **1. N A RROW STREET**

Since the Street is narrow, the wide trucks will have difficulty being careful passing by.

#### 2. TURNING AROUND

All residents and delivery trucks (UPS, FED EX, Trash Trucks, etc.) still have to be able to turn around at the Cul-De-Sac as the narrow street does not allow them to turn around in the middle of the street.

#### 3. LANDSCAPING

Some Neighbors have gentle hanging over of trees onto their street.

When trucks come by and have no run to move over, this land scape is damaged. See <u>ATTACHMENT - landscape plctures</u>.

Right now, we have ample parking on the street so the trucks "move over", and do not damage landscape.

But in the future, if parking is permitted on the street for the construction crews, this will not be possible!
