- INSTRUCT the Department of City Planning (DCP) to develop and issue guidelines for processing Eldercare Facility Unified Permits, including the acceptance of complete applications for environmental review and analysis, and the basis for approval or denial of projects.
- 2. DIRECT the DCP to submit the guidelines to Council for review and approval upon the scheduling of this matter for consideration.

<u>Summary</u>
