Dear Honorable Members:

We, Todd Rubinstein and Debra George declare that we are the President and the Parks Committee Chair, respectively of the Encino Neighborhood Council (NC) and that on March 26th, a Brown Act noticed public meeting was held by this NC with a quorum of fourteen (14) board members present and that by a vote of 13 yes, 0 no, and 1 abstention the Encino NC adopted the following resolution as a Community Impact Statement:

The Encino Neighborhood Council supports Partnerships to Combat Prostitution. Prostitution along Sepulveda Blvd and other areas of the community spills over into local Encino parks including the Sepulveda Basin and wildlife areas. The result is trash that includes hazardous waste, and an otherwise unsavory and unsafe environment for park goers and wildlife.
