ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the acceptance of Brownfields Community Area-Wide Assessment Grant funds from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- AUTHORIZE the Director, Bureau of Sanitation, or designee, to accept, negotiate, and execute all necessary grant funds from the USEPA Brownfields Community Area-Wide Assessment Grant.
- 2. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION authorizing the acceptance of the USEPA Brownfields Community Area-Wide Assessment Grant.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The Board of Public Works reports that there is no fiscal impact to the City's General Fund as a result of this action. The grant award has been approved by the USEPA, and the funds will be available this year on a reimbursement basis. There are no match requirements for this type of grant.

Summary:
