Since the adoption of the Small Lot Subdivision Ordinance (SLSO), some problems with its implementation have been encountered. Therefore, the Old Granada Hills Residents' Group Board of Directors strongly urges you to **support** the recommendations made within the most recent Planning and Land Use Management Committee Report relative to evaluating and revising the SLSO to ensure that Small Lot Subdivisions are compatible with the neighborhood. Included are the recommendations for Council action within the proposed Motion, as initiated by Councilmembers Tom LaBonge and Paul Krekorian.
