In this capacity, as a licensed real estate broker by the State of California, she oversee multiple sales and acquisitions of real property.

Prior to forming Cova, Corinne oversaw a privately-held, multi-million-dollar commercial real estate portfolio comprised of government, office and retail users. She has also worked at the highest levels of federal government, including the United States Senate, and has been integral in the operations of Democratic Presidential conventions, and non-profit organizations focused on leadership development.
