JESSICA POSTIGO was born in Philadelphia, PA but raised in the Basque Country in northern Spain where she began her professional career as a political journalist for the national newspaper 'El Mundo'. Based in San Sebastian, she wrote about the violent struggle for independence that resulted in 820 deaths since the 70's. She moved on to work for one of the country's top independent ad agencies where she created award-winning campaigns for international clients, including Newsweek, Converse and Renault over a period of four years.

Her lifelong passion for filmmaking inspired her to move to Los Angeles in 1996 where she has lived ever since. She began working in production. After line producing the documentary *Better Living Through Circuitry*, she went on to develop screenplays for various production companies, which ultimately led her to writing them for major studios. Amongst others are her adaptation of the National Book and Newberry Award winning YA novel by Nancy Farmer *The House of the Scorpion* for Warner Brothers and the true story of Columbian hostage rescue mission *Operation Checkmate* for Sony Pictures. She also adapted the new animated *Tarzan* 3D movie based on the classic novel by Edgar Rice Burroughs currently in production. Jessica adapted THE MORTAL INSTRUMENTS: CITY OF BONES which was recently released from Columbia with Unique Features and Constantine producing, Harald Zwart directing and starring Lily Collins, Lena Headey and Jonathan Rhys Meyers.

Jessica is actively involved in both national and local charity work. She's married and had two daughters, Libby (7) and Nina (4).

## Dear Ms. Postigo:

I am pleased to inform you that I hereby appoint you to the Commission on the Status of Women for the term ending June 30, 2014. In order to complete the process as quickly as possible, there are several steps that must be taken, many of which require visiting City Hall. To begin the appointment process, please review, sign and return the enclosed Remuneration Form, Undated Separation Forms, Background Check Release and Information Sheet within one week of receiving this letter. These documents are necessary to ensuring the most efficient, open and accountable City government possible. Further, Mayor's Office policy requires you to be fingerprinted as part of the background check that is done on all potential Commissioners. To do so, please bring this letter to the Background Unit of Employment Services Division, Personnel Department Building, 700 East Temple Street, Room 235, Los Angeles, California 90012. The division phone number is (213) 473-9343. Fingerprints must be taken within three working days from the receipt of this letter.

Under separate cover you will be receiving a packet from the City Ethics Commission containing information about the City's conflict of interest laws and a copy of the State Form 700/Statement of Economic Interests. You are required to complete and return this form **within 21 days** of your nomination to the City Ethics Commission, 200 North Spring Street, City Hall, 24th Floor, Los Angeles, California 90012. Any inquiries regarding this form should be directed to Shannon Prior at the Ethics Commission at (213) 978-1960.

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As part of the City Council confirmation process, you will need to meet with Tom LaBonge, your Councilmember, and Councilmember Gilbert Cedillo, the Chair of the Housing Committee, to answer any questions they may have. You will be hearing from a City Council committee clerk who will let you know when your appointment will be considered by the Housing Committee. Some time thereafter, you will be notified by the committee clerk when your appointment will be presented to the full City Council for confirmation. Once you are confirmed, you will be required to take the oath of office in the City Clerk's Office in Room 395 of City Hall. Julie Ciardullo with the Mayor's staff will assist you during the confirmation process if you have questions.

Commissioners must be residents of the City of Los Angeles. If you move at any point during your term, have any changes in your telephone numbers, or in the future plan to resign (resignation must be put in writing), please contact my office immediately.
