Summary: Support for the motion contained in Council File 13-1580, reconsidering the use of rodenticides by City Departments

Whereas, the City of Los Angeles contains extensive landscape inhabited by wildlife which we value as part of the natural heritage of our City; and

Whereas, the use of rodenticides (both 1st-generation anticoagulants such as warfarin, chlorophacinone, and diphacinone and 2nd-generation anticoagulants such as brodifacoum, bromadiolone, difenacoum, and difethialone) have been shown to cause death and disease to predators which eat poisoned rodents; and

Whereas, the Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks has already discontinued the use of 2nd-generation rodenticides; and

Whereas, other practical means of rodent control exist, including traps and owl boxes, and have been proven to be effective in other municipalities that have banned the use of all rodenticides; therefore

Be it resolved, the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council (CSPNC) supports the passage of the motion contained in City Council File 13-1580, which encourages the Department of Recreation and Parks and other relevant City Departments to reconsider their use of all rodenticides; and
