

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, TRADE, COMMERCE, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE relative to the proposed Terminal Media Operator Concession Agreement with JCDecaux/Airport Sponsorships/Time Warner for development of indoor advertising, sponsorship, and emerging media opportunities at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX).

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Board of Airport Commissioners (Board) that the proposed action is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as provided in Article III Class 1(18)(c) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE the Terminal Media Operator Concession Agreement with JCDecaux/Airport Sponsorships/Time Warner.
3. CONCUR with the Board's action of December 2, 2013 by Resolution No. 25283 authorizing the Executive Director to execute the Terminal Media Operator Concession Agreement with JCDecaux/Airport Sponsorships/Time Warner for development of indoor advertising, sponsorship, and emerging media opportunities at LAX.

#### SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on December 10, 2013, your Trade, Commerce and Tourism Committee Chair considered a Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) transmittal relative to the proposed Terminal Media Operator Concession Agreement with JCDecaux/Airport Sponsorships/Time Warner, for development of indoor advertising, sponsorship, and emerging media opportunities, at LAX, having a term through December 31, 2020 with a potential three-year extension if exercised pursuant to the terms of the agreement. Over the term of the agreement, guaranteed revenues will exceed \$180 million.

An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee Chair moved to approve the recommendations contained in the transmittal. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
